All-Hazards Incident Commander Course (L-950)

This course provides local- and State-level emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Incident Commander on an All-Hazards Incident Management Team (AHIMT). These responsibilities fall into two categories: 1) responding to the incident and command needs of the incident, and 2) effectively fulfilling the position responsibilities of an Incident Commander. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable participants to process and apply their new knowledge.

Target Audience: Emergency Management Agencies, Emergency Medical Services, Fire Service, Law Enforcement, Public Health, NGO's, and others desiring to achieve effective local incident management capability.

Prerequisites: IS 100, 200, 700 & 800; ICS 300, ICS 400
